Parties to the agreement: Järva municipality from the Republic of Estonia and Kokkola municipality from Finland

Directions of cooperation:

- green transmission;
- environment (business environment, living environment, community);
- tourism;
- culture;
- education;
- innovative solutions;
- administrative experience exchange.

Content of the agreement:

By signing this agreement, Järva municipality and Kokkola municipality assume the following obligations and responsibilities:

learn from each other and exchange experiences at all levels of local life;

contribute to the launch of joint projects and enabling local people, organizations and entrepreneurs to participate in cross-border activities in today's Europe;

to support the development of friendship between the two countries through cultural, sports, social, tourism, educational and economic activities;

organize regular mutual meetings in order to develop relations between the institutions, organizations and people of the two local governments.

The joint desire of the municipalities of Järva and Kokkola is to consolidate friendship and expand mutual ties in order to contribute to lasting peace in Europe.

This friendship agreement can be changed by mutual agreement. Changes must be approved by both parties. The parties shall immediately notify each other of changes in their legislation that may affect the performance of this Agreement.

The agreement is signed by both parties.
